IMPORTANT NOTICE

FIXING GUIDELINES

Composite decking has specific fixing requirements; we recommend that these guidelines are adhered to.

- Joists need to be spaced at maximum 400mm centres.
- Composite decking expands and contracts with temperature change similar to other outdoor surfaces. Fastening the deck boards according to the gapping requirements shown will accommodate movement.

Butt Join and Breaker Board Gapping Requirements

Outside Temperature	0°c – 15°c	16°c – 30°c	31°c and above
Required Gap	7mm Gap	5mm Gap	3mm Gap

- Allow 7mm gap where boards meet any structure. Using Oztuff hidden fixing system will ensure the correct spacing between boards.
- Butt joints should always be joined over a double joist to allow for the installation of the Oztuff hidden fixing system.
- Decking can be installed directly onto concrete using composite joists ensuring no rot or degradation.

Storage

Oztuff Decking must be stored flat off the ground on supports under cover prior to installation.
